Southampton Union Free School District is a well-regarded public school located on Long Island in Suffolk County nearly abutting the Atlantic Ocean. The District includes one high school, intermediate school, elementary school, and a bus garage. The school serves over 1,500 students in grades PK, K-12 with a student-teacher ratio of 9 to 1. The district is deeply rooted in serving a diverse community. The schools are unique in the need that the equipment needs to withstand a climate of salt air and was part of the discussion regarding equipment selection. Southampton was looking to focus on repair and replacement of aged HVAC equipment and retrofitting of all comprehensive lighting to LED, internally and externally. The district partnered with ESG to develop an energy and infrastructure program. ESG provided engineering, design, project management, and guaranteed energy savings along with a financial vehicle to garner the maximum amount of improvements. ESG also monitored, measured, and verified savings.
