MEW MILFORD, CT

New Milford is located in Litchfield County on the western border of Connecticut in the beautiful Housatonic Valley. It is the largest Town in the State and encompasses 64 square miles of land. The Schools consist of one High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, a Transitional School and two Elementary Schools. The Town buildings were a mix of DPW, Town Hall, Senior Center, Teen Center, and numerous Town facilities. The town was look to develop and energy infrastructure program. New Milford partnered with ESG who provided engineering, design , project management, guaranteed energy savings, and facilitated financing. ESG worked closely with the Town and Schools to develop a self-funded program focused on infrastructure renewal and reducing capital spending.

SOLUTION

The primary focus of this project is to repair and/or replace aged HVAC equipment and utilize all funding sources available in Connecticut. This project utilizes Eversource and its incentives, PURA, CT's LREC program and Class III Rec's as additional funding sources.
